



## **AVID Pre-College and Postsecondary Support**

The professional learning and resource support for pre-college and postsecondary programs.

- a. **AVID Pre-College and Postsecondary Professional Service**: The collection of AVID services and products includes access to the AVID postsecondary materials and methodologies.
