

Sheraton Grand Seattle Transportation Options

Driving Directions

HEADING NORTHBOUND ON I-5 (FROM PORTLAND/TACOMA)

From I-5 North, take Exit #165 - Seneca Street (left hand side on the freeway). Stay to the right on the exit ramp and take a right onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.

FROM THE SEATAC AIRPORT (I-5 NORTHBOUND)

Depart SeaTac Airport following the signs to the freeways. Take Hwy 518 East to I-5 North (Seattle) and follow rest of directions from above.

FROM THE SEATAC AIRPORT (509 NORTHBOUND - ALTERNATE ROUTE)

Depart SeaTac Airport following the signs to the freeways.

Take Hwy 518 West to the Seattle exit for 509 North. (509 will merge onto the Alaskan Way / Hwy 99.)

Take exit for Seneca Street/1st Avenue, take a left onto 1st Avenue, and take a right onto Spring Street.

Take a left onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.

HEADING SOUTHBOUND ON I-5 (FROM CANADA AND AREAS NORTH OF SEATTLE)

From I-5 South, take Exit #165B Union Street.

Turn right at the 2nd traffic light onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.

HEADING SOUTHBOUND (HWY 99/AURORA - ALTERNATE ROUTE)

From Hwy 99 Southbound, take the City Center/Denny Street exit.

Cross Denny Street to 7th Avenue (the street to the left of the Elephant Car Wash sign).

Follow 7th Avenue and veer right onto Westlake Avenue (Mc Donald's will be on your right).

Westlake will merge into 5th Avenue.

Proceed four blocks and turn left on University Street.

Take a left onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.

HEADING WESTBOUND ON I-90 (FROM ISSAQUAH, SOUTH BELLEVUE)

From I-90 Westbound, take I-5 North Exit #165 - Madison / City Centre.

Turn left onto Madison Street and cross over the freeway.

Take an immediate right onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.

HEADING WESTBOUND ON 520 (FROM REDMOND, NORTH BELLEVUE)

From 520 Westbound, take I-5 South Exit #165B - Union Street.

Turn right at the 2nd traffic light onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.

FROM THE FERRY TERMINAL / PIER 52 (HEADING EASTBOUND)

Turn left (North) onto Alaskan Way and stay in the far-right lane.

Take the 2nd right onto Spring Street and follow uphill.

Turn left onto 6th Avenue - Hotel entrance/Valet parking will be on the right side between Union and Pike Street.



¹ Sheraton Grand Seattle Parking Information

The Sheraton Grand Seattle Parking Garage handles parking for hotel guests and visitors and is exclusively valet parking (self-park not available) garage.

Overnight guests driving oversize vehicles can be accommodated at the Sheraton Grand Seattle Hotel. There are 8-10 spots for vehicles up to 8', which are available on a first-come first-serve basis. If our over-sized parking area is full, public parking for oversize vehicles is available at the Washington Athletic Club Garage (entrance just past 6th & Union – first entrance on the left). The WAC garage clearance is 7'. Parking at the WAC is on a first-come, first-served basis. The Hotel has no special arrangements with this garage.

Guests attending events who are not overnight guests (daily drive-in) are always welcome to park at the Hotel based on availability. If the garage is full you will be directed to utilize any of the self-park garages in the area near the Hotel at public rates at each garage.

For those groups who have contracted for event or shuttle bus transportation during their conference, note that the Hotel must be notified of any bus pickup/load intended at the Hotel. If you have questions regarding bus activity in the vicinity of the Hotel, please contact your Hotel representative for detailed load-zone information.

LINK LIGHT RAIL

Central Link light rail travels between Westlake Station in downtown Seattle and Sea-Tac Airport, making 11 stops along the way. Link trains run every 7.5, 10 or 15 minutes depending on the time of day.

Hours: Monday-Saturday, 5:00am-1:00am; Sundays & Holidays, 6:00am-Midnight

Fares (one-way): Adults - \$3.25; Youth ages 6-18 - \$1.50; Children under 6 ride free with fare paying passenger **Tickets must be purchased prior to boarding the train. Tickets are available at the Ticket Vending Machines on Link train platforms.*

SEATTLE STREETCAR (SOUTH LAKE UNION LINE)

Connects Downtown Seattle to South Lake Union. Streetcards run at 10-minute headways during the weekday 4:00pm-6:30pm peak period and at 15-minute intervals at all other times. 
From SeaTac Airport, taxi cabs are available across from the concourse in the parking lot. There are signs directing to transportation services. Fares are approximately \$60.00 from the Airport to the Sheraton Seattle (TRAFFIC PERMITTING) by meter, and a flat rate return to the Airport from Downtown (fuel surcharges may be added).



RENTAL CARS

It is recommended to reserve a car in advance. If you would like to rent a car, the hotel concierge can assist in making reservations, and some agencies have a special hotel guest rate when making reservations through the concierge. Hertz, Alamo/National, Budget, Enterprise, Dollar and Avis rental agencies are within the downtown area (listed by closest proximity to the Sheraton).

Car rental agencies are open Monday-Friday, 7:00am-6:00pm; Saturday-Sunday, 9:00am-4:00pm. Some agencies allow pick-up in downtown and drop-off at SeaTac airport without additional charge. Some agencies will accept a car downtown after picking up at the airport. Rates vary by car type, agency and date.
