How Do We Know?

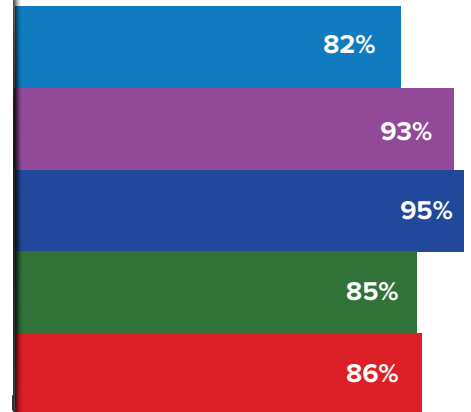
82% reported taking at least one course of rigor.

93% are completing 4 years of rigorous coursework necessary to be eligible for college admission.

95% have been accepted to 4-year colleges/universities, validating their postsecondary readiness.

85% submitted the FAFSA.

86% plan to attend either a 2- or 4-year college.

How Does This Happen?
